POSITION OVERVIEW

The duties of a Labourer vary widely. Work includes using a variety of power and hand tools. This position is required to work outside in all types of weather. Proper care is essential to this role, as some tasks are inherently dangerous or involve working with, near or beside heavy equipment, water and/or chemicals.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES

- Performs varied types of work connected with the various projects undertaken by PortsToronto.
- Must be able to work in a marine environment.
- Must adhere to all PortsToronto policies and procedures.
- Must comply with all Health and Safety policies, procedures, SOPs and legislated requirements
- Must wear designated safety equipment (PPE)
- Type of work includes, but is not limited to, heavy labour, construction and repair, maintenance, harbour cleaning, bridge operation, painting and preparation of outside structures, etc.
- Perform outdoor seasonal duties such as general garden maintenance (lawns and flower beds), snow removal, etc.
- Other related duties as assigned by PortsToronto.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Valid Ontario Class "G" Drivers License required; Class "D" or "DZ" would be a definite asset.
- Valid Forklift Certification is required.
- Possess a recognized First Aid Certificate is recommended.
- MED A1 or 2 would be an asset

ABILITIES

- Must have experience in construction and/or marine labour.
- Must be able to work independently as at times will have limited supervision.
- Must be in good physical condition and able to climb and work at varying heights.
- Must be able to lift up to 25 Kgs (50 Lbs) floor to waist.
- Able to swim and tread water for two (2) minutes is recommended.

HOURS OF WORK: 7½ hours per day between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.; 5 days/week. Shift work may be required. Weekends and holidays may be required.

- Criminal record check will be conducted on hire
